CHINESE MEDICINE ORDINANCE (Chapter 549)

ORDER MADE BY THE CHINESE MEDICINE PRACTITIONERS BOARD OF THE CHINESE MEDICINE COUNCIL OF HONG KONG

Notice is hereby given that the Chinese Medicine Practitioners Board of the Chinese Medicine Council of Hong Kong, after an inquiry on 5 January 2021 conducted pursuant to section 56(1)(d) of the Chinese Medicine Ordinance (Chapter 549, Laws of Hong Kong), was satisfied that the following act of TO Kai-kwan, registered Chinese medicine practitioner (Registration No.: 003125) as prescribed under section 56(1)(d) of the Chinese Medicine Ordinance, is proved:—

Since the expiry of his last practising certificate on 25 June 2015, registered Chinese medicine practitioner TO Kai-kwan, being a person required to be the holder of a practising certificate under section 76 of the Chinese Medicine Ordinance, has continued practising Chinese medicine without obtaining such a certificate for a period exceeding 6 months.

Pursuant to section 56(1)(d) of the Chinese Medicine Ordinance, the Chinese Medicine Practitioners Board decided on 5 January 2021 that, for the above established fact, the name of TO Kai-kwan be removed from the Register of Chinese Medicine Practitioners with effect from 5 January 2021.
