* The Chief Executive announced on 8 April 2020 the measures of the second round of Anti-epidemic Fund, including the waiver of registration and related fees for healthcare professionals as a token of appreciation to healthcare professionals in the fight against Coronavirus Disease-19.

The Food and Health Bureau has issued a press release on 27 May 2020 announcing that the waiver will be valid for three years with effect from 1 July 2020. During the concession period, the fees payable in respect of statutory registrations/enrolments for the 13 healthcare professions, which include registered CMPs, as well as the fees payable in respect of the issuance and/or renewal of practicing certificates that take effect during the concession period will be waived.

The Government has published pieces of subsidiary legislation in the Gazette on 29 May 2020 to give effect to the waiver. The relevant statutory fees will be waived during the concession period (i.e. from 1 July 2020 to 30 June 2023).

As far as the statutory fees relating to registered Chinese medicine practitioners are concerned, the fees to be waived during the concession period include application for registration as a registered CMP, application for or renewal of registration as a registered CMP with limited registration, and application for the issue or renewal of a practicing certificate. The waiver is applicable to applications for registration or practicing certificate that takes effect during the concession period, irrespective of the actual date of submitting the application. If the registration or practicing certificate takes effect outside the concession period, the relevant application fees will not be waived. Besides, each applicant for application for or renewal of registration as a registered CMP with limited registration can have the fee waived one time at most, whichever is the earlier.
